

| 3) | Counter floor | Spruce boards grade I/III 4-side planed, KD 4000x96x17mm Distance/clear approx. 42mm Stapled to elastic beam, joints centred Stagger: min. 2 elastic beams |
| 4) | Elastic beam | 1-layer build-up 4000x96x27mm Spruce boards grade I/III 4-side planed, KD Elastic pads from SPORT PUR cushion mat 10mm |
